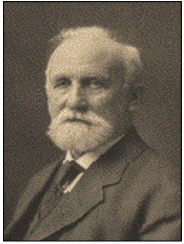


About the Sweet Lecture Series



John Edson Sweet, one of the founders of the Technology Club of Syracuse -- now known as the Technology Alliance of Central New York, or TACNY -- left a trust so one of his principles would carry on: enlightenment from discussing technological advancements in our society.

Since 1916, TACNY has sponsored a minimum of six lectures a year in the series named after John Edson Sweet. The lectures are free and open to the public, and include an opportunity for attendees to mingle before and after the event.

Most Sweet Lectures are held in Room 101 of Whitney Applied Technology Center on the Onondaga Community College campus. Networking starts at 5:30 p.m., the speaker is introduced at 6 p.m., the presentation is slated to run from 6:15 to 7:30 p.m., and the event ends at 8 p.m.

Each lecture is followed by questions from the audience.

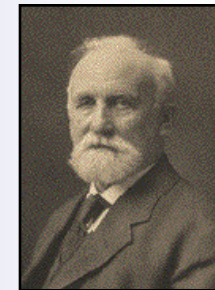

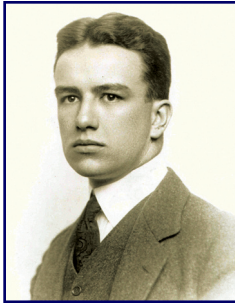

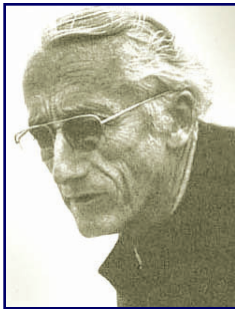
